Ordinary Time

We are now in what is known in the church year as Ordinary Time, from the word "ordinal," which simply means counted time (First Sunday after Trinity, etc.). The first section of Ordinary Time starts on the day after Candlemas (2nd Feb) and ends on Shrove Tuesday, the day before Lent. Ordinary Time resumes after Pentecost and always begins with Trinity Sunday and ends with Christ the King Sunday (last Sunday before the beginning of Advent).

During Ordinary Time we may use the readings to help us to learn how to live out our Christian faith in our everyday lives. The Liturgical colour for Ordinary Time is green, which has traditionally been associated with new life and growth.

The churches in Derry Hill and Bremhill are open daily to anyone seeking a quiet, peaceful space.
