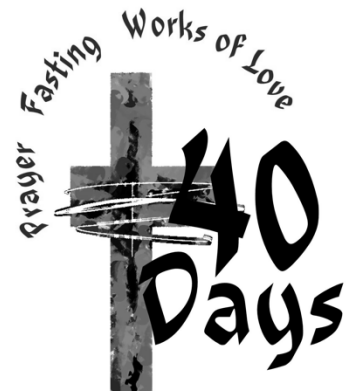

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Communion in the Marden Vale Team

Current Church of England guidance states that in the event of increased community transmission of coronavirus, priests should take a view whether it is necessary to withdraw the Common Cup, and to consider suspending handshaking or other direct physical contact during the sharing of the peace. In the Marden Vale Team, for the time being, whoever is presiding at the Eucharist will intinct the wafers (using a pipette) to enable everyone to receive the sacrament in both kinds and in the same manner.

We will refrain from shaking hands at the Peace. Smiles are welcome or you may wish to use British Sign Language to share the Peace.
